## BOARDING & DAY CARE

### WHO WILL CARE FOR MY "CHILD" WHILE I'M AWAY?

We offer quality boarding services and will take excellent care of your four-legged children, whether it's for a vacation or just one night. We also offer Day Care - a great option for busy families who might otherwise leave their children home alone for long periods during the day. The boarding provided is in a clean and spacious air-conditioned "room" with comfortable bedding. Feeding is twice a day. Our kennel assistants are trained, friendly, caring and love looking after dogs.

### EXERCISE TIME

Dogs are walked several times a day, plus have outdoor play-time in the enclosed exercise area; cats have a special indoor play-room. With your permission, your children will get play time with their best friends, so there's plenty of opportunity for fun!

### WHAT IS PROVIDED DURING THEIR STAY?

Each pet is provided with food, bedding and toys, but you can bring their toy, pillow or blanket. We can administer the medications you provide. Please let us know any fear or concern your child has. We want all our guests to be as comfortable as possible.

Please make reservations so that we are ready to welcome you and your child. **Drop-off and pick-up is during regular business hours ONLY.**

Without any exceptions, animals boarding with us are required to be **up-to-date with vaccinations**. All pets must be free of internal parasites, fleas and ticks! All dogs will be bathed the day before they go home.

## REQUIREMENTS FOR DOGS

**VACCINATIONS INCLUDE:** Rabies, Bordetella, Influenza, and DHLPPC. A stool exam will be done upon admission to check for internal parasites. Dogs are also required to have flea/tick prevention (applied at the time of drop-off and must be approved by our veterinarian). You must supply proof of vaccination history and fecal testing from your veterinarian if you decline any from our hospital.

## REQUIREMENTS FOR CATS

**VACCINATIONS INCLUDE:** Rabies, Feline Leukemia, and FVRCP. A stool exam will be done upon admission to check for internal parasites. If not presently receiving the Feline Leukemia vaccine, you will be required to test for Feline Leukemia and Feline Immunodeficiency Virus and then vaccinate — **no exceptions!** Cats are also required to have flea/tick prevention (applied at the time of drop-off and must be approved by our veterinarian). You must supply proof of vaccination history and fecal testing from your veterinarian if you decline any from our hospital.
